Uniform Violations

Students must dress for success. The cooler weather does not permit for variations in the uniform. Students may wear an undershirt or white t-shirt under their clothing as long as it is not visible. Girls may wear white or blue tights instead of socks. Only blue monogrammed sweaters or sweatshirts and monogrammed red fleece are allowed to be worn during the school day. All other jackets, sweaters or shawls must be removed while the student is in the building. Athletic shoes may only be worn during P.E. Socks must be white. No colored or character printed socks. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.

We have an ongoing **uniform exchange** in the room left of the stage. If your child has outgrown a uniform, you may donate it to the school and pick up a larger size, if one is available.

We just ask that all uniforms are in good repair and washed when you bring them in.

Don't forget to start saving your unwanted items for the PTA Garage Sale scheduled for May 8th from 8:00 am - 11:30 am at the school.

General Uniform Guidelines

- All polo shirts, jumpers and sweaters must have the Noonan Elementary Academy monogram.
- Uniforms must be laundered appropriately and wrinkle free.
- All shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- All garments must be appropriately labeled with a permanent marker.
- Modest hair accessories for girls.
- All shoes must have a non-marring sole.
- Navy Embroidered Sweater/Sweatshirt/Jacket
- Red Fleece Jacket

Boys Uniform Pre-K to 4th Grade

- Red Polo with Embroidery
- Pleated Navy Shorts or Pants
- White Socks

Boys Uniform 5th to 8th Grade

- Striped Oxford Dress Shirt
- Navy Tie
- Pleated Navy Shorts or Pants
- White Socks

Girls Uniform Pre-K to 4th Grade

- White Peter Pan Collar Blouse
- Plaid Jumper
- White Anklet Socks

Girls Uniform 5th-8th Grade for

- Plaid Kick Pleat Skirt
- Oxford Shirt with Embroidery
- Plaid Tie
- White Anklet Socks
