LANGUAGE:

We talked about mammals and their characteristics. Mrs. Piper read some interesting books such as Cha Cha Chimps, Baby Bear, Baby Bear What Do You See?, and Hello, Hello. The children always enjoy this theme about animals.

CRAFT AND WRITING:

The children completed several worksheets this week. They found the snowman that was different from the others, counted from 6-12, and had to find the shortest/longest item in each row. It was fun to marble paint a zebra and to see what color stripes the children chose! We ended the week, cutting and gluing the mammal in its correct environment.

CONCEPT:

Something amazing happened this week in Miss Callanan’s class. The beans hanging up on the windows grew! Everyone was so excited to see that some of them were so tall they were coming out of the Ziploc bag. In our discussions about mammals, we talked about armadillos and a Tasmanian devil.
